## SCHEDULE

<i>Description of item</i>	<i>Rate of Cess</i>
Suspension dried hides, wet-salted hides, raw cattle hides, calfskins, sheepskins, wool sheepskins, goat skins, donkey skins, crocodile skins and camel hides.	1%
Hides and skins processed to wet blue state.	0.75%
Hides and skins processed to pickle form.	1%
Hides and skins processed to crust form.	0.5%
Hides and skins processed to finished leather.	0.5%
