## CONDITIONS.

- (i) Only the original copy of the permit is valid for movement of forest produce specified.
- (ii) This permit is valid only for a single journey- and forest produce specified in (3) above.
- (iii) This permit can only be issued by Zonal Manager.
- (iv) This permit does not apply to small quantities (e.g a head-load of firewood and 3 bags of charcoal) of forest produce for domestic use.
- (v) This permit is not applicable to forest produce purchased from a licenced sawmiller and accompanied by an official delivery note.
- (vi) Forest produce from Forest Reserve must have a Revenue Hammer Mark where applicable.
- (vii) Officer supervising removal of forest produce must sign original and duplicate copies of permit to signify removal of produce specified in (3).
- (viii) The Permits should be for all forest produce irrespective of source.
- (ix) Issuing of Permits will be done during working days and not over the weekends and public holidays.
- (x) The movement permit will be issued on production of a certificate of origin for the forest produce.
- (xi) There are permits issued for **Kshs. 1,000.00, Kshs. 1,500.00 and Kshs. 2,000.00**
- (xii) Transport of forest produce must be done during day-time hours (from 6a.m to 6 p.m).
